- Level one award in Health and Safety.
- Banksman training, COSHH.
- Asbestos awareness, safe work at height.
- Site visits.
- Level one employability skills.
- Employer expectations.

Gordon said: "Having suffered from chronic depression and anxiety, I'd often been told I was unemployable but the programme gave me the confidence to start applying for work... I am now looking forward to the future and buying my own home."
