Working with prisons on the pallet to planter up-cycling scheme in Hull

In Hull we are supporting skills for people on prison sentences by providing them with old pallets and funding for joinery training.

They are 'upcycling' them into planters used to produce healthy food when installed in the local community. The recipients of the planters, in the local community, volunteer or undertake activity that gains them community credits via Investors in Community in order to receive the planters for Free.

Partnering with Investors in Community, the participants also receive community credits for creating the planters, that can be exchanged for vouchers and goods, once they are released. Through gaining skills and contributing to the community, they are positioning themselves for greater work and volunteering opportunities on release.
